Homework Incentives

Reading

If your child reads 5 times a week, he/she will get a sticker on the class chart. If this happens for a term they will receive a bookmark. If they manage to read for a whole term they will receive a bronze reading certificate, followed by a silver reading certificate and then a gold reading certificate for 3 completed terms.

Other Homework

If your child completes homework on time they will get a sticker or homework stamp. If they do this for half a term their name will go into a draw for a WHSmith voucher.

Recommended time

The Government recommended time allocation for homework for Year 5 and 6 is 2½ hours per week.

Please could you support your child, as they will be asked to complete their homework in Golden Time if it is not completed.

Children are expected to complete their homework.

Homework that will be set in Year 6

- Literacy homework/Booster homework
- Reading for five minutes a day, five times a week & some comprehension
- Fortnightly writing in home writing books
- Spelling strategies
- Numeracy homework, times tables and work to consolidate learning
- Homework recorded in diaries
- Any other work that we feel is needed to reinforce lessons
- Occasional research into something for topic or science
