Recommended time

The Government recommended time allocation for homework for Year 1 and 2 is 1 hour per week.

Please could you support your child, as they will be encouraged to complete their homework by the staff.

Homework Incentives

Reading

If your child reads 5 times a week, he/she will get a sticker on the class chart. If this happens for a term they will receive a bookmark. If they manage to read for a whole term they will receive a bronze reading certificate, followed by a silver reading certificate and then a gold reading certificate for 3 completed terms.

Other Homework

If your child completes homework on time they will get a sticker or homework stamp. If they do this for half a term their name will go into a draw for a WHSmith voucher.

Homework that will be set in Year 1

- Number work including number bonds and telling the time
- Reading for five minutes a day, five times a week (Letters & Sounds)
- Fortnightly writing in home writing books
- Oral spelling rehearsal (segmentation of words, e.g. cat = c a t)
- Any other work that we feel is needed to reinforce lessons
- Occasional research into something for topic or science
