Our theme this term is
Ancient Greece
We will be learning about...

In **maths** we will be ensuring all children are confident in using the formal written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be working with fractions, decimals and percentages and looking at equivalence between the two. We will be investigating perimeter and area of rectangles, triangles and parallelograms

In **science** we will be studying: classification of living things, food chains and food webs and light (shadows, reflection - how light behaves).

We will be linking **art and D&T** lessons to our topic of Ancient Greece (by making coil pots from clay), developing observational drawing skills to create our own mythical creature and to draw artefacts.

Topic work – the different Gods, the Olympics, home-life and the roles of women and the differences between the Spartans and Athenians.

RE - Islam

In **literacy** we will be writing in a variety of genres linked to Ancient Greece: myths, poetry inspired by The Iliad, persuasive letters, instructional texts and an adventure story.

Homework - Read 5 times a week and record in homework diary. Learn spellings. One piece of literacy homework and one piece of maths homework will be set each week to be handed in by the following Thursday.
