In MATHS we will be developing a number of areas including: multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and time. In year 4, children need to have a sound knowledge of times table facts up to 12 x 12 and their corresponding division facts.

In SCIENCE we will be exploring plants. This will include naming and identifying the different parts of plants and looking at their function. We will be growing a variety of different plants this term and using them in experiments.

In art and design we will explore the art of Monet and be using fabric to design and make something based on his style and ideas.

In HISTORY the children will explore the history of the rainforest. This will include looking at how it is used by different people and interpreting different sources of evidence.

We will be looking at the history of the tribes which live in the rainforest and how deforestation has changed the rainforest over time.
