Our theme this half term is
The Romans.
We will be learning...



In **MATHS** we will be studying a number of areas including: place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, and fractions and decimals.

In **SCIENCE** we will be learning about states of matter (Solids, liquids and gases) and exploring sound.

In **ART/DT** we will be creating a variety of Roman weaponry using different materials. We will also learn about Roman mosaics and create our own.

In **PE** children will be taking part in dance, and games. They will need to have the correct PE kit of a red t-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls/trainers in school at all times.

In **COMPUTING** we will be focusing on different multimedia, formatting and using search engines.

In **RE** we will be finding out about the faiths of Buddhism and Hinduism.

In **ENGLISH** we will link our writing with our topic work including story writing, poetry and non-chronological reports.

In **HISTORY and GEOGRAPHY** we will be exploring the topic of Ancient Romans. This will include comparing city and rural life in Europe and in the UK.

Our weekly **HOMEWORK** will be:

- One piece of English or maths set per week
- Multiplication Facts
- Spellings

The children are expected to read to an adult at least five times a week. This should be recorded in their reading record book which must be brought in to school everyday.
