In MATHS we will be studying a number of areas including: multiplication and division, fractions and decimals and time. In year 4, children need to have a sound knowledge of times table facts up to 12 x 12 and their corresponding division facts.

Our weekly **HOMEWORK** will be:

- Maths worksheet
- --Spellings
- TT Rockstars and Mathletics online should also be used regularly where possible.

The children are expected to read to an adult at least five times a week. This should be recorded in their reading record book which must be brought in to school everyday.

In **SCIENCE** we will be learning about electricity, what makes a good insulator or conductor, making simple circuits and being safe with electricity.
