Time Traveller ★

Visit a museum and draw the oldest object you can find (2 hrs)
Find out something interesting that happened in the year — or on the day — you were born, and write or draw it (1 hr)
Find the oldest building near you, look for a clue to its age & draw it (1 hr)

Planet Protector ★

Collect 10 pieces of litter, then sort it into recycling and rubbish (1 hr)
Make a bird feeder from a bottle or pot & hang it outside (1 hr)
Help your whole house go greener: pick a habit to change (less waste, fewer car trips, lights off), get everyone to join in & keep it up for a week (1½ hrs)

Nature Detective ★

Build a den outside from sticks, blankets or boxes & take a photo (1 hr)
Hunt for 3 different minibeasts, draw each one & note where you found it (1 hr)
Plant a bean in a pot, then measure & draw it each week (1½ hrs)

World Explorer ★

Learn to say hello & count to 5 in a new language, then teach someone (1 hr)
Choose another country, draw its flag & write 3 facts about it (1 hr)
Try a food from another country & describe how it tasted (½ hr)

★ **Local Legend** ★

Visit your local library, borrow a book & read it (1½ hrs)
Design a poster about something you'd like to change & put it up (1 hr)
Hold a fair family vote on a real choice (a film, the weekend plan, dinner): everyone gets one vote — count them up & most votes wins! (1 hr)

Never Give Up ★

Learn a brand-new skill from scratch — a cartwheel, juggling or a shoelace bow — and don't stop until you can do it (1½ hrs)
Set yourself a 7-day challenge to get better at one thing (skips, keepy uppies, reading). Chart your score daily, then write what improved & what was hardest (2 hrs)
Read about a real explorer or athlete & write how they never gave up (1 hr)

Mini Inventor ★

Build a marble run from cardboard tubes & test that it works (1 hr)
Be a scientist: predict if 5 objects will float or sink, test each one, record results & work out what the floaters have in common (1 hr)
Pick something you use daily, find out who invented it & draw it (1 hr)

Journey Maker ★

Animals migrate too! Find an animal that travels a long way (a swallow, turtle or whale) & trace its journey on a map (1 hr)
Interview a family member about a journey they made — ask 3 questions & write their story (1 hr)
Imagine moving abroad: pack a pretend suitcase of 5 things & say why (½ hr)

Kindness Champion ★

Do 3 secret acts of kindness & write what you did (1 hr)
Make a kindness pebble: paint a kind message on a stone & leave it to be found (1 hr)
Write down 3 things you are grateful for, every day for a week (1 hr)

Everyone can be an explorer

Everyone can be an explorer! These challenges are designed so that every child can take part, no matter where they live or what they have at home. Activities can be done at home or nearby, and can be adapted for different ages. The important thing is to have fun, try something new, and keep learning!
