The Essex Children's University™ is a part of the national Children's University™ organisation that provides 7 to 14 year olds (and 5 and 6 year olds learning with their families) with exciting and innovative learning activities and experiences outside normal school hours.

Please find a temporary passport with this letter. Please encourage your children to get this filled in when they attend clubs in and out of school. Once they have 10 hours in this passport, then it can exchange this for a real passport available from Miss Riches for a fee of £5. This will allow children to try things out before making the commitment to Children's University. Hours will be transferred from the temporary passports. If your child already has a full passport, then please continue to use that. Lost passports can be replaced by purchasing one from the office for £5.

If your child has previously been a part of the Children's University then please count up their collected hours and do Jo Miss Riches with the total number of hours. These will then be recorded. If we do not receive the current hours total children will start back at zero hours.

Learning Destinations

Learning Destination can range from a museum to a farm or from an airport to a university, as long as the learning activity connects with study you can undertake at University for the 'grown ups'. Learning Destinations display the CU Learning destinations logo prominently inside and outside their environment, clearly visible to children who may want to use their Passport to Learning.

At a Learning Destination, Children's University students can get their Passport to Learning stamped so they can log their hours. Places which provide Children's University validated learning activities and which are publicly accessible, such as museums, wildlife centres, castles, zoos, sports coaching, libraries, theatres etc. Children can also gain hours from school clubs.
