Red words Irregular words that cannot be sounded

out

Story green words Decodable words that will be included in

the storybook

Speedy green words Decodable words in the storybook that

children should be able to read at speed

rather than Fred talking first.

Fred in your head Still sounding out a word but doing so in

your head rather than out loud, helps

build fluency.

Special friends Two or three letters working together to

make one sound e.g. sh, ch, igh, air, a-

e, i-e.
